





<u>What is NC GreenPower?</u> NC GreenPower is a nonprofit, statewide organization dedicated to improving North Carolina's environment by connecting consumers with providers of energy generated from renewable ("green") resources and offering carbon offsets to balance or reduce the impact of greenhouse gas emissions.

How does the program work? Participation is completely voluntary and you can opt to donate on your utility statement. Previous contributions of \$4 have supplied 100 kilowatt-hours (kWh) of energy produced from green resources such as solar, wind, and water. As of April 1, 2015, the NC Utilities Commission approved the distribution of a \$4 contribution to be split evenly with \$2 purchasing 50 kWh of green power and \$2 supporting the installation of solar PV demonstration projects at North Carolina K-12 schools.

What about my contribution? NC GreenPower contributions will be itemized on your monthly utility statement. Contributions are collected on the customer's behalf by the City of Shelby and transferred in their entirety to NC GreenPower. Donations to the 501(c)(3) charity are tax deductible to the extent allowed by the law.
