NUISANCES: Fact Sheet

Examples of nuisances:

- High grass, weeds and undergrowth that is 18 inches or taller,
- An accumulation of:
 - oTrash and garbage,
 - oStagnant water,
 - o Building materials, glass, or wood,
 - o Household appliances or tools,
 - olnoperative lawn care equipment,
 - o Upholstered furniture designed for indoor use,
 - o Broken, inoperative, or discarded furniture,
 - o Packing boxes,
 - o Discarded clothina,
 - o Junk metal,
 - o Automobile parts or tires,
 - olnoperative boats,
 - o Motorized equipment or machinery,
 - o Animal waste,
- An open well,
- Abandoned structures.

The City of Shelby Code requires staff to give an offender at least 15 days to abate a nuisance prior to enforcement action. The time period for compliance varies depending on the particulars of a case.

The City of Shelby may abate certain nuisances not corrected by the owners of property. The property owner is responsible for all abatement expenses which may be attached as a lien to a property.
