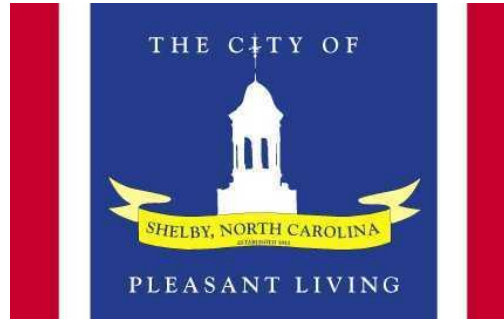

What is “COP CAMP?”

“COP CAMP” is a one week long Summer Day Camp for kids. This camp is designed to create a positive partnership between our children, police officers, and the community. We accomplish this through several different fun-filled, educational activities.

What will my child learn in “COP CAMP?”

How do I enroll my child for “COP CAMP?”

Registration for “COP CAMP” will start April 20, 2009. Registration forms can be picked up at the Shelby Police Department on Lafayette Street and at the Shelby Police Sub-Station located inside the Cleveland Mall.

Will there be any requirements to participate in “COP CAMP?”

Yes, there will be requirements that each child must meet. The requirements will be:

1. Your child must be between the age of 8 and 13.
2. Live or attend school in Shelby.
3. Must have transportation to and from camp location.
4. Must abide by “Conduct Rules” set forth by the police department.

When and where will “COP CAMP” take place?

“COP CAMP” will take place at Shelby City Park located at 850 W. Sumter St., Shelby. Your child’s age will determine when they would attend camp. Camp will begin at 8:00 a.m. and end at 4:00 p.m. each day. The following dates have been identified for the different age groups:

- June 15-19, 2009 for ages 8-9
- July 13-17, 2009 for ages 10-13

“COP CAMP” is made possible by utilizing resources from the Police Department and the City Park along with donations made

from community partners. There is no cost to camp participants.

A parent must accompany any child with special needs or is handicapped.
