The City of Shelby and the Shelby Police Department are proud to offer the *Are You O.K.?* program. This program is designed for older adults, disabled persons, shut-ins who live alone, or anyone in our community who needs to be checked upon daily. There will be no charge of any kind for this service.

Are You O.K.? is a computerized telephone calling system which is operated free of charge by the Shelby Police Department. The system calls each enrolled subscriber every day of the year at the same time of day.

The Are You O.K.? calls will be made in the morning between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. Each subscriber will be asked to choose an hour during which he or she prefers to be called. The calls will always be made in the same order, so people will quickly learn exactly when to expect them.

When the subscriber picks up the phone he or she will hear a voice saying, "Good morning, are you okay?" If the subscriber fails to answer the phone after several tries, or if there is a busy signal several times in a row, the computer immediately notifies the police telecommunicator who will then send a patrol unit to check on the person.

During holidays, vacations, or any other time the subscriber plans to be away, a simple call to the Police Department will stop the calls for as long as needed.

The system is currently being used in numerous cities and towns throughout the United States and Canada. It has saved a number of lives and reduced the worry and anguish for countless citizens and their friends and family.

Everyone who signs up for this service will be asked to fill out a short form with medical and other information, which the police may need, in an

emergency. This information will be kept totally confidential. It will be kept in a secure location at the Police Department and only used by the Police as needed.

If you wish to sign up, or if you think you might be interested and would like to talk about *Are You O.K.?* with someone, please call Terry Grayson at the Shelby Police Department (704-484-6845) any time Monday through Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. or, if you prefer, you may fill out and mail the coupon on the back of this brochure.
