City of Shelby Adds First Electric Vehicle to Fleet

The City of Shelby is excited to announce the addition of the first electric vehicle to the City fleet! The vehicle will be used by the City's Planning and Development Services Department and will be charged using the EV charging station located beside the old police department.



This energy efficient vehicle is a 2023 Nissan Leaf S Hatchback model and can travel up to 149 miles on a single charge; saving the City several hundred dollars in annual fuel costs!

ChargePoint CT 4021 Dual Port Level 2 Charging Stations



Did you know that the City of Shelby offers two locations for FREE electric vehicle charging? Both charging stations are located in Uptown Shelby and offer dual port charging for multiple vehicles. They are the only free public EV charging stations in Cleveland County.

The first is located at 118 Campbell Street in the Bobby Bell Pavilion parking lot, and the second is located at 311 S. Lafayette Street behind City Hall beside the old Police Department.

Since 2017, the City of Shelby has offered Energy Efficiency Grants to assist local Uptown Shelby businesses operating in buildings 100 years old or older.

Many of these buildings have poor insulation, as well as outdated windows, doors, and HVAC equipment that do not meet energy efficiency standards that are common today. This in turn leads to high energy costs for businesses in the uptown area.

The City's grant program is designed to assist these business and property owners by providing funding to help in the cost of new energy efficient doors, windows, HVAC equipment, and/or insulation.

City Hall Sidewalk Replacement Project

Hotel Charles Project

The City is seeking an experienced development partner to revitalize the Hotel Charles as an upscale boutique hotel. The Hotel Charles is a historic building located in the heart of Shelby's uptown district, and its future use is viewed by the City as an important next step within Shelby's downtown revitalization efforts.

Within the 32,000 square feet building, there is approximately 3,000 square feet of retail space on the street-level floor, 6,000 square feet of food and beverage space on the first floor, and the opportunity for 35-38 hotel rooms on the 2nd and 3rd floors.

History of the Hotel Charles

Originally built in the late 1800s as the Central Hotel, and later named the Hotel Charles, the three-story building was damaged by a fire in 1928. After re-opening in 1929 the hotel was renamed the Charles Hotel and continued to operate until 1967. The building is listed on the National Registry of Historic Places and is currently owned by Bank of OZK.
